- **2.3.** Since 2003, TechFest has served over 10,000 of our Dayton youth, where over sixty exhibitors present innovative technology. The IEEE Dayton Section and the WSU IEEE student chapter developed an IEEE booth for TechFest 2008. We developed a poster board or backdrop for the booth as well as to construct several 'follow the wire path' games. The follow the wire path game consists of a curved wire attached to battery and light/buzzer, the other lead of the battery goes to a wire loop. The goal of the game was to maneuver the loop around the wire curves without activating the light/buzzer. This activity provided interaction for the students at the event. The project board and associated handouts were focusing on why STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) subjects are not only important, but are also fun.
