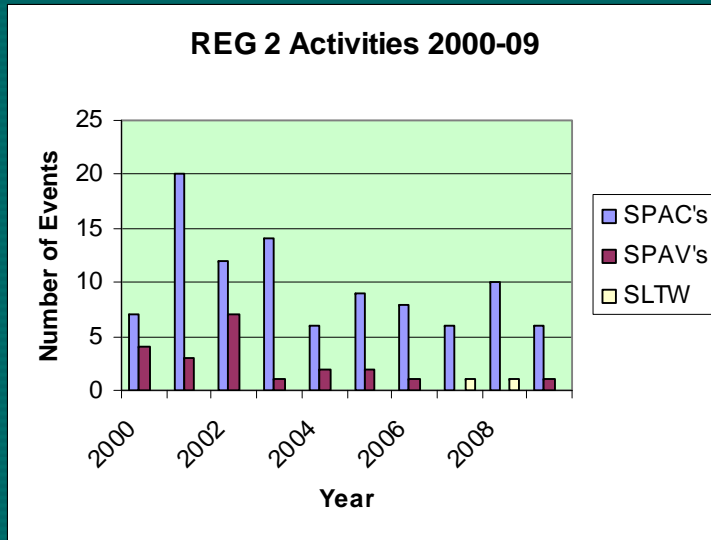


S-PAC REG 2
